Dress Code 2026-2027

Rationale

Windsor State School has implemented a student dress code because we believe it:

- Promotes a safe environment for learning by enabling ready identification of students and non-students at the school
- Promotes an effective teaching and learning environment by eliminating the distraction of competition in dress and fashion at the school
- Promotes a supportive environment at the school by fostering a sense of culture and belonging
- Fosters mutual respect among individuals at the school by minimising visible evidence of economic, class or social differences
- Creates a good image of the school within the community and encourages students to uphold and enhance that image

The Uniform consists of the following items:

*Blue or Black undergarments worn for the provision of extra warmth, UV protection or cultural reason are accepted

Uniform Expectations

- All students are expected to wear the full school uniform daily.
- Students must wear the school's formal uniform (not sports uniform) when leaving the school on an excursion unless otherwise specifically informed of variation.
- School hats must be worn outside of the classroom in line with the Sun Safety Policy.
- Polo shirts/ House Polo Shirts are strongly encouraged to be worn on a Thursday during Pastoral Care lessons.
- Sun shirts and swimming caps must be worn for all swimming lessons.
- The formal school uniform is strongly encouraged to be worn by all students on a Monday.
- If a child cannot wear the proper school uniform for the day or for a particular activity, parents are requested to inform the school in writing or via email.

Grooming

- Students' hair must be neat and tidy and of natural hair colouring only.
- All hair that falls over the collar should be tied back to help minimise the spread of head lice.
- Hair accessories (e.g. hair bands, clips etc) are to be blue or white in colour. House colours may be worn on carnival days

Jewellery and Makeup

- The only acceptable jewellery items are a watch, stud or sleeper earrings or a medical alert bracelet/necklace.
- Simple analogue or digital watches are encouraged. To limit distractions any Smart Watch must have alerts turned off as per our Code of Conduct [The Use of Personal Technology Devices](#)
- Make-up is not a part of the school uniform and must not be worn. This includes eyelashes and fingernails that are of an appropriate length and are natural in colour.
