This funding will be used to:

Improve student learning outcomes in Literacy and Numeracy with particular focus on Reading and Writing. Outcomes from this funding will:


- Increase the percentage of Year Three & Five students achieving results in the Upper Two Bands of the 2017 NAPLAN Literacy tests to 75% of eligible students.
- Increase the percentage of Year Three & Five students achieving results in the Upper Two Bands of the 2017 NAPLAN Numeracy tests to 75% of eligible students.
- Ensure 100% of eligible students, in Year Three & Five, achieve above the National Minimum Standard (NMS) for all strands in the 2017 NAPLAN Tests.

Our initiatives include

- Develop an enhanced Whole School Curriculum and Assessment framework which includes effective data analysis, planning, assessment strategies and moderation.
- Improve learning outcomes by focusing on consistent high quality teaching practices throughout the school.
- Provide high levels of professional support from skilled practitioners to enhance classroom teachers' ability to drive the school's improvement agenda.
- Provide opportunities for targeted early intervention and extension strategies in classrooms and in out of school hours support programs.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Create the position of Head of Curriculum (HOC) to support the school focus on consistent high quality curriculum, development and implementation for improved Literacy and Numeracy student outcomes. \$92 000
- Provide early targeted intervention for students by purchasing additional Teacher Aide time to ensure all classrooms have support for Literacy and Numeracy blocks. \$68 640
- Resourcing to support further implementation of school priorities, (i.e. improving the standard of reading and writing achievement for all students and fully embed Reading program; integration of digital technologies (ICTs) to implement an innovative approach to curriculum delivery) to ensure high quality teacher professionalism and pedagogy. \$46 730
